SAIL WEEKEND SIGN UP

RCSCC Falkland has three (3) sail weekend training dates assigned for this year's summer sailing period. These weekends are provided by the Cadet Nautical Centre at CTC Connaught and are provided to advance sailing skills for those cadets interested in obtaining CANSail 1 and potentially CANSail 2 sailing levels. These qualifications are civilian qualifications and are awarded based on the Sail Canada requirements.

Cadets are permitted to sign up for more than one weekend, however it is important to note that they may not be loaded on more than one. Sail billet allocation will depend on a few factors such as: number of cadets registering, previous participation (those cadets that are close to achieving levels will be prioritized to ensure they have the required time to complete the necessary skills check for their level), attendance and participation in Wednesday parades, attendance and participation at weekend training. Lunch will be provided for all cadets participating so please ensure that any dietary requirements are noted so arrangements can be made in advance. Food accommodations cannot be made on the grounds for cadets that have not identified food requirements during this registration period.

The following weekend and billet allocations are available for registration:

- June 1st-2nd, 2024 (8:00am-4:30pm): 30 billets
- June 15th-16th, 2024 (8:00am-4:30pm): 16 billets
- June 22nd-23rd, 2024 (8:00am-4:30pm): 30 billets

Please use the registration link below. Registration will be open until Wednesday May 22nd, 2024. Cadets that have been selected for each training weekend will be notified and further information will be provided at that time.
